OPERATION: Sack Lunch will tailor volunteer opportunities to your schedule. We offer short term, partial day, and engaging work for small to medium sized groups. We also offer special projects for larger groups and regularly scheduled, daily, weekly, or annual volunteer opportunities.

Overview:

- Volunteer hours are normally between 9 AM-7 PM, Monday–Friday
- AM shift begins at 9 and ends at 2
- PM shift begins at 2 and ends at 7
- Hours are flexible
- Saturday volunteer shift is from 1 to 6:30
- Our kitchen is located at the Compass Center (210 Alaskan Way South, Seattle...)
- Our outdoor meal site is at 6th & Columbia, meal service times 1PM-2PM
- Volunteers under the age of 18 will require a permission slip signed by a parent or legal guardian. School groups need to be signed by the responsible adult chaperone
- Volunteers under the age of 18 must have an accompanying and supervising adult

We suggest that volunteers wear clean, comfortable clothes and shoes. You will be on your feet! Be sure to layer clothing in the winter, as it will be hot in the kitchen and cold outside. Hair must be tied back or worn in a hairnet that will be provided by OSL. OSL is a scent free environment. Please do not wear strong perfumes, colognes, or deodorants. In a small heated up environment scents can cause headaches, etc... Gloves must be worn at all times while handling and preparing food. Please leave valuables at home.
